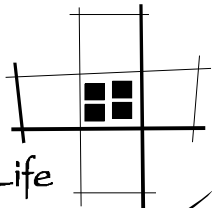

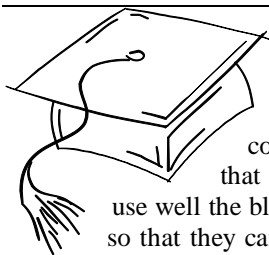

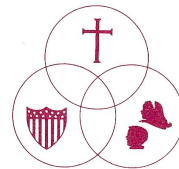
St. Therese School Openings GRADE OPENINGS St. Therese School
